Organ Donation  
Awareness

Letter dated 2003-02-05 from Carolyn Ross, SSW, Patient Services Coordinator, The Kidney Foundation of Canada regarding Organ Donation Awareness was received for information.

Ms. Ross addressed the Committee with an overhead presentation regarding the need and importance of organ donation. Mr. Frank Horan, President, Irish Heritage Club of Sudbury, and Ms. Yvonne St. Jean, Co-ordinator, Trillium Gift of Life Network, assisted Ms. Ross in responding to questions from the Committee.

Item 3  
Smoking By-law  
Implementation/  
Education Committee

Report dated 2003-03-31, with attachment, from the General Manager of Economic Development & Planning Services regarding Smoking By-law Implementation/Education Committee was received.

Councillor McIntaggart addressed the Committee regarding the City of Greater Sudbury Smoke-Free Public Places and Workplaces By-law and introduced Ms. Westhaver and Mr. Gutjahr, members of the Smoking By-law Implementation/Education Committee.

Ms. Shelley Westhaver, Public Health Project Manager, Tobacco By-law, and Mr. Bryan Gutjahr, Manager of By-law Enforcement, City of Greater Sudbury, addressed the Committee with an overhead presentation regarding implementation of By-law 2002-300 which will take effect on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2003.

The following areas of concern were addressed:

- Inclusion of a multi-sector task force - adequate representation from the stakeholders such as bar owners and restaurants;
- Policy implementation and budget impact - full costs of hiring of additional by-law enforcement officers and education material;
- Approach and tone of the by-law
- Visitation to all work places prior to implementation

Councillor Davey requested a **deferral** of the recommendation until the May 14<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Priorities Committee pending a report from the General Manager of Economic Development & Planning Services addressing the aforesaid issues.

The consensus of the Committee was not obtained for the requested deferral and the following recommendation was presented:
