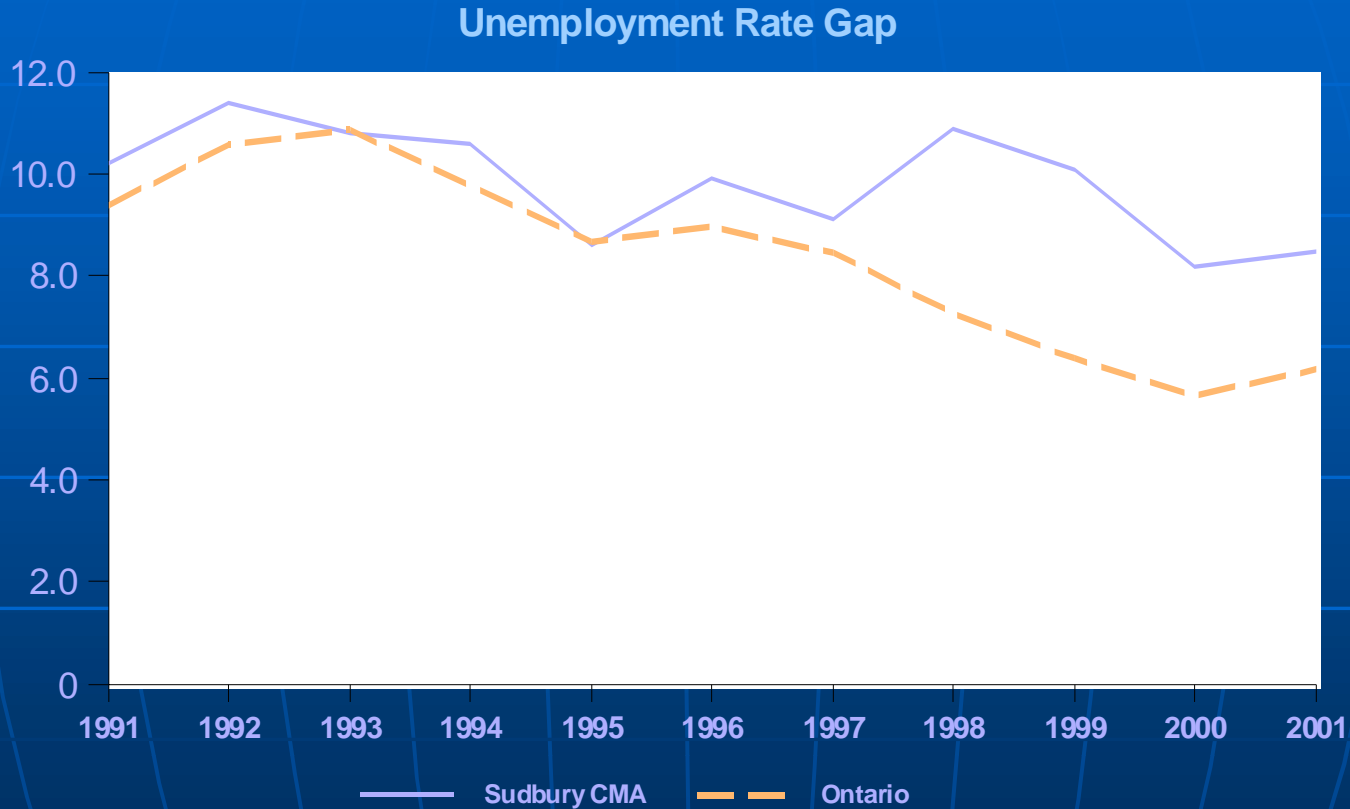

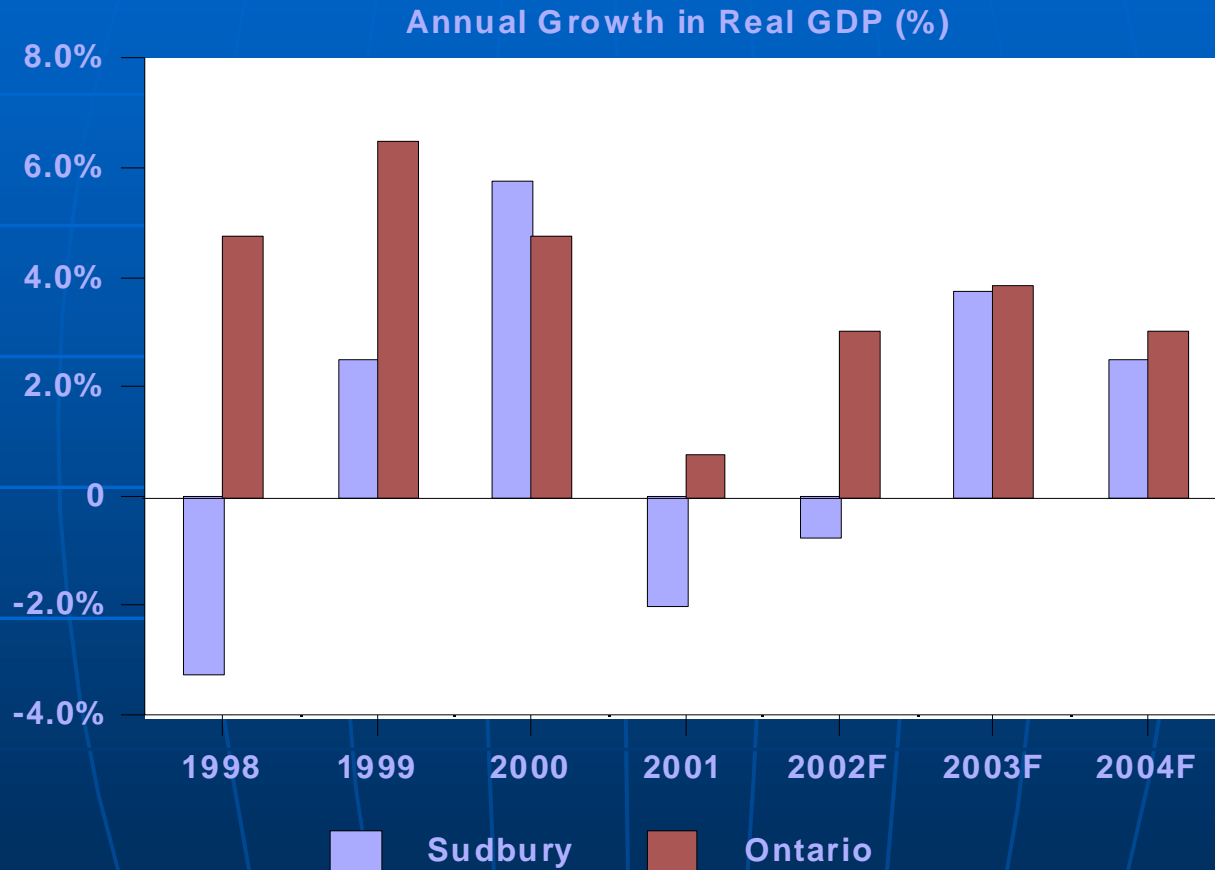

# Sudbury's GDP Growth

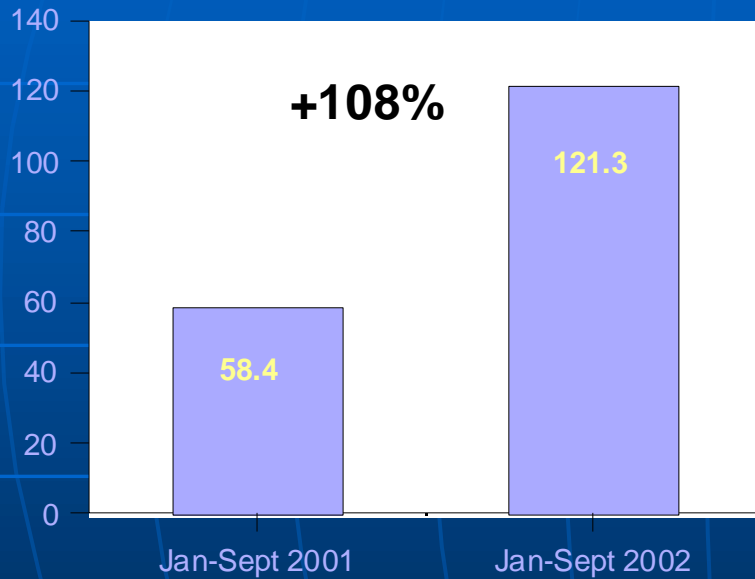

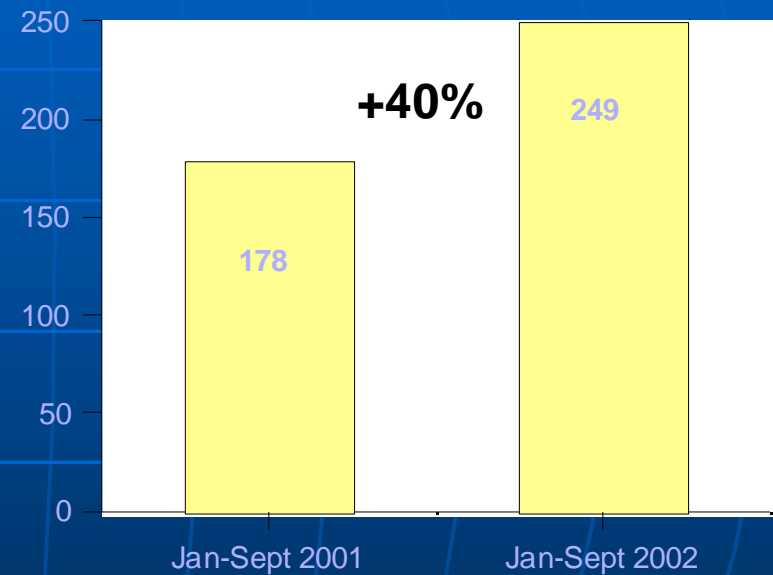

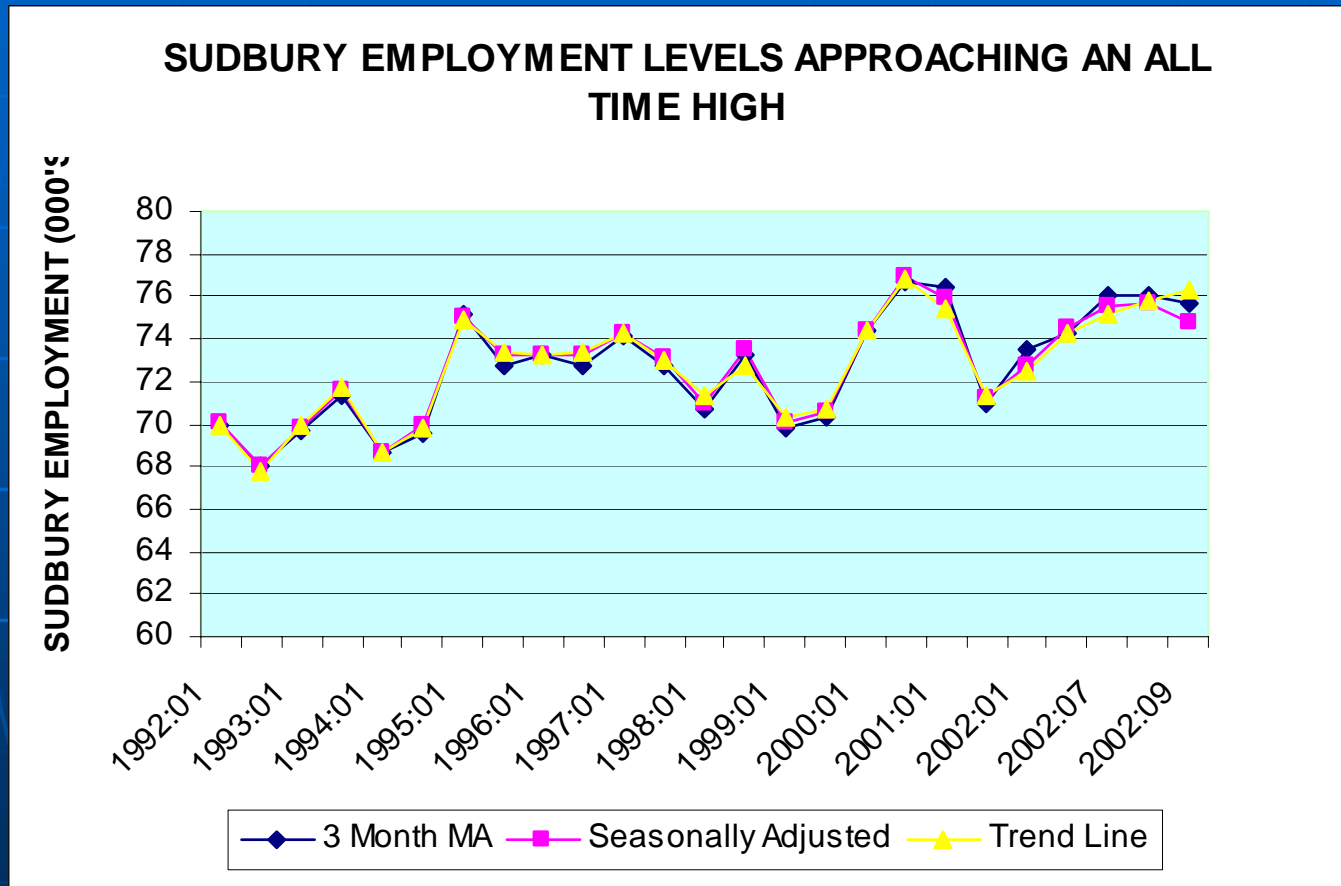
Total Construction Value (million \$)
